BOAT YARD RATES

<u>Straddle lift haul out</u>	under 50 feet: \$8.00/foot	50 feet and over: \$10.00/foot
<u>Hard moorage</u>	\$30.00 per day	
<u>Hard moorage by the week</u>	\$150.00 per week	
<u>Dry dock haul out</u>	\$17.50/foot, plus \$65.00 per hour to set up dry dock for haul out	
<u>Dry dock moorage</u>	\$75.00 per day	
<u>Pressure wash</u>	\$65.00 per hour	
<u>Crane</u>	\$125.00 per hour (includes machine and operator)	
<u>Forklift</u>	\$75.00 per hour (includes machine and operator)	
<u>Transient floating moorage</u>	double Port of Toledo daily transient rate – (see back for rates) (includes 110V electricity, does not include 220 or 440 3 phase)	
<u>Service pier</u>	\$75.00 per day does not include 220 or 440 3 phase electricity	
<u>220 or 440 3 phase electricity</u>	\$16.00 per day	
<u>Work barges</u>	\$20.00 per day, Tug service additional	
<u>Disposal Fees:</u>		
<u>Oily bilge water</u>	\$1.00 per gallon	
<u>Used clean oil</u>	\$.25 per gallon	
<u>Anti-freeze</u>	cost plus mark-up	
<u>Labor rate</u>	\$65.00 per hour.	

All invoices are due before departure.

PAST DUE amounts shall accrue interest at the rate of 1 1/2 % per month (18% APR).

Collection Fee: A \$35.00 Administrative charge and the collection agency fees will be assessed on any account sent for collection.

Returned check fee: \$25.00 + Bank fees.

Custodial Care: Double the daily transient charges plus any Port labor involved in attending or showing vessel.

All vendors must be pre-approved by the yard manager.

A \$10.00 per hour fee will be charged to outside vendors working in the yard.

The Boat Yard Manager has the authority to renegotiate and make any necessary rate adjustments if any unforeseen circumstances may arise.

Owner agrees that the storing of owner's personal property upon Port property is at owner's risk. The Port of Toledo does not assume responsibility for loss or damages to any property within the Port area. If for any reason the Port decides that the personal property is creating a hazard, the Port reserves the right to have the property removed from Port property without notifying the owner in advance. The Port reserves the right to remove the property and sell the property pursuant to Oregon law in the event the owner fails to pay applicable storage charges. Owner is responsible for any cost, plus ten percent including reasonable attorney fees incurred in removal or sale of the property due to a hazardous nature, non-payment and/or abandonment.
