

**POKER PADDLE**  
**Saturday, August 21 and Sunday, August 22, 2010**  
**11 AM- 2 PM each day**

**OFFICIAL RULES**

This is a FUN event for all, where SAFETY is first and foremost. The Poker Paddle is based on a 5-card poker game, where the best hand wins. Cards sealed in envelopes will be picked up by you at 4 on-the-water inner tube stops. You'll receive your 5<sup>th</sup> card when you return to the Wooden Boat Show Port Information Booth.

1. There are 5 stops where you will pick up a card. Four are on the water – look for inner tubes with mailboxes attached. Stop by the inner tube and select one envelope at each inner tube. DO NOT OPEN THE ENVELOPES! They will be opened by Port Staff at the end of the race.
2. The Poker Paddle runs from 11 AM- 2 PM. It is not a race and is not competitive. You can complete your stops as quickly or slowly as you choose. You must turn your envelopes in no later than 2 PM.
3. Coast Guard-approved PFD's should be worn at all times. Participants should also be mindful of OSMB & Coast Guard boating safety regulations.
- 4 A parent or guardian must accompany those under the age of 18 and sign a waiver prior to race start time.
5. Registration is \$10 per person and must be paid at time of submitting your registration form. You may play more than one hand of cards at a cost of \$10 per hand.
6. Participants are required to use good judgment and navigate the waters carefully and safely.
7. NO ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED AT THE BOAT LAUNCH AREA OR ON THE BOATS DURING THE RACE.
8. Officials and judges reserve the right to make all decisions in regard to any part of this event and their decisions are final.
8. Prizes for players with the best hand and 2<sup>nd</sup> best hand will be available at the Port Information Booth at 2:15 PM.
